On September 21, 2023, Masuda Funai held its Annual Employment Seminar at the DoubleTree by Hilton in Arlington Heights, IL. This session featured insights from speakers Nancy Sasamoto, Frank Del Barto, Eldon Kakuda, and Hirokazu Kishinami.
