## VISA BULLETIN FOR FEBRUARY 2016

The Department of State (DOS) released the monthly Visa Bulletin and below is a summary of green card Final Action Dates and Dates For Filing dates for employment-based immigrant visa categories for the month of February.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Per a new USCIS policy, a week after the Department of State (DOS) issues its monthly Visa Bulletin indicating immigrant visa availability for the next month, the USCIS will make its own separate determination on green card availability. If green cards are available for a certain category, the USCIS will post its own notice on its website at: [www.uscis.gov/visabulletininfo](http://www.uscis.gov/visabulletininfo) to alert immigrants applying in those categories with more availability, that they may use the Dates for Filing chart and not the Final Action Date chart. Thus immigrants may no longer rely on the DOS Visa Bulletin, but must wait one week after its publication and then look to the USCIS to see whether a green card is available to them.

**BELOW IS A SUMMARY OF CHANGES FROM THE VISA BULLETIN FOR LAST MONTH FOR FINAL ACTION DATES:**

- The EB-2 China category has **advanced one month** from February 1, 2012 to March 1, 2012.
- The EB-2 India category has **advanced six months** from February 1, 2008 to August 1, 2008.
- The EB-3 World and Mexico categories **remain stalled** at October 1, 2015.
- The EB-3 China category **advances three months** from July 1, 2012 to October 1, 2012.
- The EB-3 India category **advances one month** from May 15, 2004 to June 15, 2004.
- The EB-3 Philippines category **advances two months** from November 1, 2007 to January 8, 2008.
- The EB-5 China advances **a few days** from January 8, 2014 to January 15, 2014.
