Bob White Conducted an Immigration Workshop for the Illinois Institute of Technology

On Wednesday, March 31, 2021, Bob White, Principal of Masuda Funai's Immigration Practice Group, conducted an immigration workshop for the Illinois Institute of Technology ("IIT") entitled "Virtual Immigration Update Workshop for International Students."
